Key Underwriting Financial Indicators for FY18 are: Member Reserve ratio as a percent of claims: 29.7%; LCRP free reserve ratio as a percent of Pool claims: 84.19%; Administrative Ratio: 5.8%. \$.94 of Premium Dollars are used for Benefits. The market value of investments as of September 30, 2018 was \$155,440,670.

BUSINESS UPDATE:
